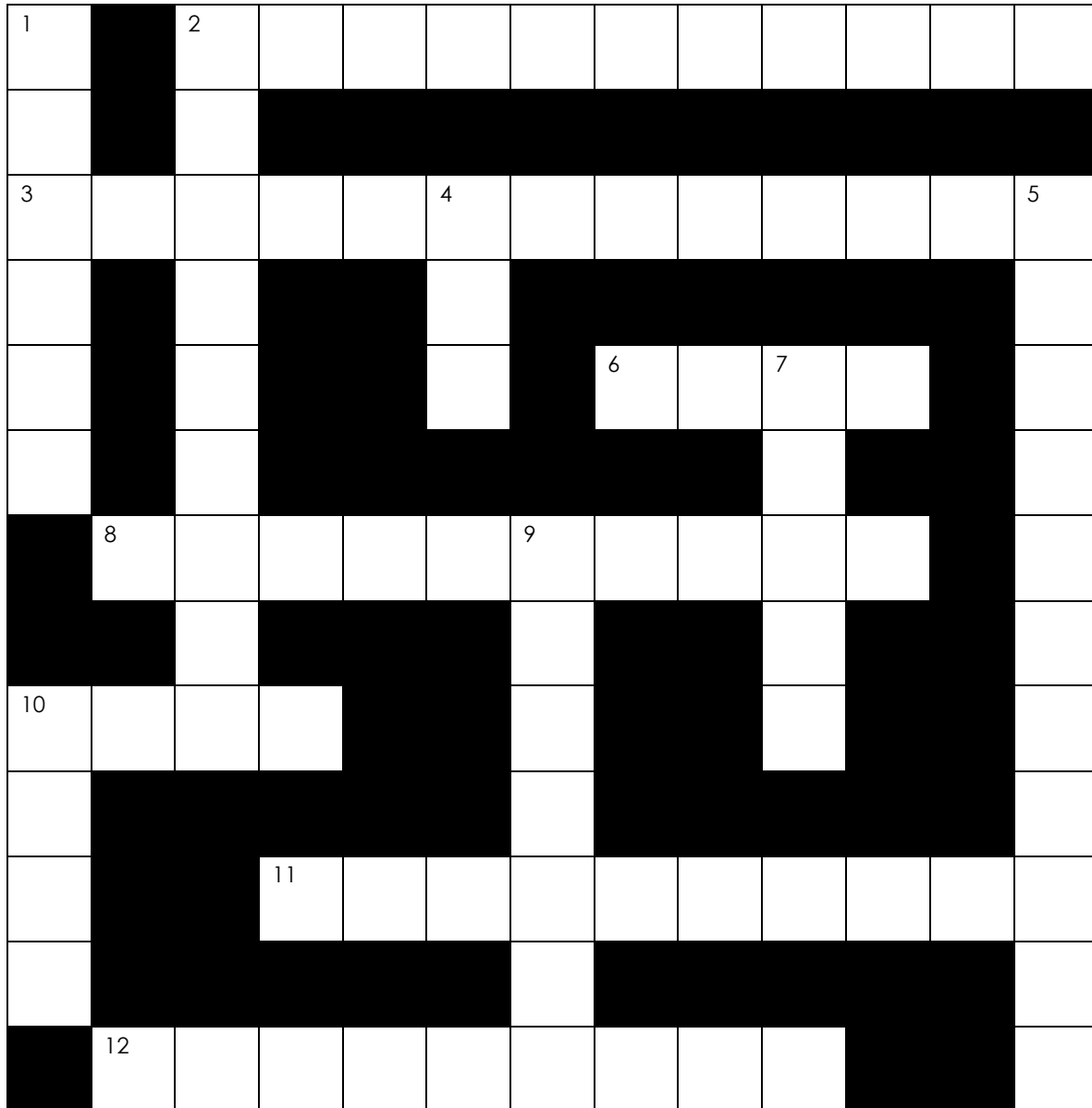




CSBS BALLET CROSSWORD

ACROSS CLUES:

- 2 It means “a running step” and is a small quick move of 3 steps
- 3 The name of the step means “to bring together”, and in Grade 4 we learn to take the working leg from the front to the back
- 6 In the Studio directions, side 4 is on your _____ ?
- 8 An allegro step alternating feet from 5th to 5th
- 10 In previous grades you learned a ‘petit’ version of this allegro step which springs from one leg to the other
- 11 The French term for a hop
- 12 A ‘spin’ one one leg using a relevé

DOWN CLUES:

- 1 An open line with the arms in 4th
- 2 An allegro step - the French term translates as “step of the cat”
- 4 You should have your hair in this style
- 5 This is a sharp rise bringing the front foot up under the knee then closing behind. Used in a pirouette.
- 7 A bend on one leg
- 9 A jump taking the feet from 5th to 2nd
- 10 What you do in allegro
